

BOROUGH OF AKRON COUNCIL MEETING- NOVEMBER 27, 2017

Council Members present- John Williamson, President; Justin Gehman, Vice-President; Thomas Murray, Nathan Imhoff, Monica Hersh, Keith Landis. (Earl Shirk not present)

John Williamson called to order the November 27, 2017 Borough of Akron Council Meeting.

Nathan Imhoff made a motion to increase park rental rates effective 1/1/2018

Moncia Hersh seconded the motion. After more discuss Council decided to have the increases effective immediately. Both Nathan Imhoff and Monica Hersh amended their motion and second to the motion to have the increase effective immediately. Motion carried.

Council discussed increasing the rent for the park house. Council requested a history on the rent for the park house before making a decision. Sue Davidson will e-mail this information to Council tomorrow.

Tom Murray made a motion to rescind Resolution#00199 for the Fulton Bank Truck Lease for the borough Crane Truck .The truck purchase did not take place by November 15, 2017 so this resolution must be rescinded and replaced with an updated resolution because of the tax exempt nature of the lease. Nathan Imhoff seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tom Murray made a motion to adopt Resolution #00200 approving the Master Lease with Fulton Bank and the purchasing of a 2017 Ford Crane Truck in the amount of \$87,781.00. Nathan Imhoff seconded the motion. Motion carried. There was a roll call on the vote. John Williamson, Justin Gehman, Thomas Murray, Nathan Imhoff, Monica Hersh and Keith Landis all voted yes for the motion.

Sue Davidson distributed a copy of a letter from PennDot. PennDot will be collecting traffic data on municipal owned roads to screen and prioritize locations for potential safety improvements. This will take place between October 2017 and February 2018.

Justin Gehman made a motion to authorize the Borough Manager to mail letters to home owners and businesses on Walnut Street and Front Street (except for the Rail Trail side) to repair and or replace sidewalk and curb before 2019. Walnut and Front Streets are scheduled for repaving in early 2019. Keith Landis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tom Murray made a motion to authorize the Borough Manager to advertise for a part-time zoning officer. Justin Gehman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Justin Gehman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Keith Landis seconded the motion. Motion carried.
