Nathan Imhoff made a motion to authorize the Borough Manager to reach out to the Lancaster County Consortium and to join in the negotiations through the Cohen Law Group for a cable franchise agreement with Comcast for a flat fee of \$3,900. Darryl Witmer seconded the motion. Motion carried.
